The first part of these 24 hours light winds from the E and clear middle calm latter part strong down gale

Lat 22.46 Long

Tuesday 18 Commenced with light winds from the W by S and clear finished strong down and washed off at 1/2 past 5 saw whale lowerd away saw no more of them called them Black Fish middle part light winds with rain from N.E. latter part strong wind from every point in compass

Lat 21.53 Long

Wednesday 19 At 1/2 past 3 took strong trades from the S.E. and clear middle part the same strong N by W latter part took in studding sails showed the booms and yards luffed to the wind soon as

Thursday 20 first part of these 24 hours squally with wind from S.E. and middle latter part the same saw a plenty of Hump Backs

Lat 17.16 Long 11.16 W

Friday 21 Commenced with strong Gale from S.E. and clear middle and latter part the same 20 ends as well

Lat 15.53 Long 7.46 W

Saturday 22 These 24 hours strong winds from the S.E. and clear middle and latter night winds

Lat 15.53 Long 10.24 W

Sunday 23 first part of the 24 hours light wind from the S.E. and pleasant middle part the same At 4 A.M. were round and hauled back the main topsail and lay till daylight were round again and stowed by the wind latter part strong Gale

Monday 11 Mo 20 1836

These 24 hours commenced with light winds from the S by E and clear middle and latter part came to anchor in sea port of Callao in 7 fathoms of water latter part chasing Hump Backs unsuccessful

Lat 12 Long 76

Tuesday 10 Mo 25 first part light winds from S.E. and clear got of 90 fms water middle part overcast latter part went on shore after water

Wednesday 11 Mo 26 Got off the raft of water and so forth middle and latter part at hand busy

Thursday 11, 27 Stowed down water first part latter part stowed watch ashore on liberty

Friday 28 first the same latter part stowed watch on liberty

So ends

Saturday 29 first part stowed watch on liberty latter part stowed watch
