These 24 hours light breezes from S.E. and pleasant finished stowing down and washed off and S.E. saw a sail to the windward

Thursday 22 These 24 hours moderate breezes from S.E. and pleasant standing by the wind

Friday 23 These 24 hours moderate breezes from S.E. and pleasant At 30 minutes past 11 raised whales off our weather quarter At 12 lowered away all three boats

Lat Long

Saturday 24 These 24 hours light breezes from the S.E. and pleasant the boats off chasing whales to the windward At 4 PM boats came on board steering by the wind

Lat Long

Sunday 25 These 24 hours light breezes from S.E. and pleasant At 1 PM raised whales lowered away and took one to the ~~boat~~ L Boat

At 5 PM took him along side and took up the boats at sunrise called all hands and commenced cutting in At 6 AM raised whales off our lee At 1 PM lowered away the two L Boats and took one to the L Boat the West Boat fastened and draved At 12 took him along side ~~boat~~ L Boat

Monday 26 These 24 hours light breezes from S.E. and pleasant first part cutting in latter part boiling At 5 PM spoke the Magnolia again with 1800 steering by

Tuesday 27 These 24 hours fresh breezes from S.E. and clear employed at boiling steering by the wind to and fro

Wednesday 12mo 28. 1836

These 24 hours fresh breezes from S.E. and pleasant finished boiling At 1 AM washed off decks nothing more remarkable steering by the wind

Thursday 29 These 24 hours light breezes from S.E. and pleasant course at West at sunset shortened sail At daylight made sail steering by the wind

Friday 30 These 24 hours light breezes from S.E. and pleasant steering by the wind stowed down our oil

Saturday 31 These 24 hours light breezes from S.E. and cloudy saw several shoals of Black fish and one finny back

Sunday 1mo 1. 1837 These 24 light breezes and pleasant steering by the wind

Monday 1mo 2 These 24 hours fresh breeze from South East and clear At 11 AM lowered away West Boat and took a Black fish

Tuesday 3 Commenced with light air from the S.E. At 12 PM hauled 4 Pows to the Eastward shoals of Black fish all around us lowered the three boats fastened and drew

Wednesday 4 All these 24 hours fresh breeze from the S.E. and clear standing on 12 hour Sacks
