These 24 hours pleasant Gales from the S and E and Clear at 2 PM commenced cutting finished one whale by sunset At daylight commenced on the other Starboard Boat Chubing whales - at 10 she came on board

Tuesday 17 of Jan Light Air from the S.E. and Clear At 1 PM commenced Boiling at 4 PM hoveed and fastened the Starboard Boat At 5 PM took along side

Wednesday 18 of Jan

First part light wind at Starboard part Calm employed at Boiling

Thursday 19 of Jan Strong Gales from the S.E. by S and Clear weather cooperating and Boiling At 12 finished Boiling

Friday 20

Light Air from S.E. & all hands engaged at washing decks Coopering Oil So At 2 PM saw a shoal of sperm whales on our S.B. Dist 7 miles at 3 PM toward the S Boats they proved unsuccessful at sunset took them along side when running fast to the Sward At daylight commenced Quatting out the hold to slow down Oil. Lat Long
