

Saturday 1st Mo 21 1837 This 24 hours light winds from the S E employed at Stowing Oil Late Long

Sunday 22 Light winds from the S E and cloudy Stowing Oil Late Long

Monday 23 This 24 hours strong winds from the S E and cloudy finished Stowing down our oil. Stowed off the hold &c Late Long

Tuesday 24 Strong Gale from the South toward S E astward washed a Ship Cooper engaged setting up Shroues on the 1st Mo Late Long

Wednesday 25 This 24 hours light winds and Calm saw a plenty of Fish during the day Late Long

Thursday 26 This 24 hours fresh Air from the S E and Clear At 2 P M saw a whale a head 3 miles at S toward the Boats and fastened the S Boat & took him along side at Daylight commenced cutting at 11 finished at 6 A M saw a shoal of sperm whales toward the Starboard Boat but of no avail as usual Late Long

Friday 27 Light winds from the S E and Clear At 4 P M saw a shoal of whales of our Lu Bow 4 miles at 5 P M toward the Boat at Dark the Boats came out board Whales swimming fast to the windward spoke the Victory Cotton of New Bedford 14 Mo 800 with all hands engaged at boiling Late Long

Saturday 28 of This 24 hours light winds from the S E and Clear looking spoke the Ship Water Scott Mastered 5 1/2 months out Clear Ship Late Long

Sunday 29 Moderate winds from the S E by East and clear at 6 P M finished boiling saw a Ship running before the wind Late Long

Monday 30 saw a ship on our Lu Quarter sailing Late Long

Tuesday 31 Light Air from the S E and Clear Stowing Oil saw nothing remarkable Late Long

Wednesday 1st Mo 1 1837 Light Gale from the S E and Clear finished Stowing down our Oil and Stowed off the Hold Late Long

Thursday 2 This 24 hours light winds from the S E and Clear standing by the wind in different fashions Late Long

Friday 3 Light Air and Clear from the S E and standing by the wind Late Long saw nothing

Saturday 4 This 24 hours light Gale from the S E and cloudy with some rain falling noggery &c Late Long

Sunday 5 This 24 hours nothing worthy of Note Late Long

Monday 6 Strong Gale from the S E and Clear At 3 P M saw a shoal of whales toward but the whales were going to fast Late Long
