and Nothing Remarkable
Late Long

Saturday 13 day of February 1837

Light air with calms Sailing in
for the main land All hands
employed at fitting rigging &c
Late Long

Sunday 14 Moderate winds from the
S.E. and clear fitting rigging Sailing
&c Late Long

Monday 15

Light air from the S.E. and
pleasant fitting rigging Sailing to
the Eastward Late Long

Tuesday 16

All hands busy fitting ship
bound to Callao do Engas &c
Late Long

Wednesday 17 1837

Inside 24 hours fresh Gales
from the S.E. and clear Sailing in for the
main land supposed to 50 days
Late Long

Thursday 18

Light Gales from the S.E. and
clear later part calms At 3 P.M. made
the Island called St. Lorenzo Dist 30 miles
at 30 minutes past 11 came to anchor in 7
fathoms of water
Late Long

Friday 19

Painting spars & sitting up
shocks for water later part All hands
on Liberty

Saturday 20

first part of these 24 hours all
hands on Liberty later part painting
spars sitting up shocks finished at 11
P.M.

Sunday 21

at 4 P.M. Light winds and clear
watering ship and ship Lucia capt
Swift from Valparaiso and Columbia
ship & schooner &c

Monday 22

Clear weather and wind till 3 P.M.
Ship Action Lira Rossa with a whole boat
picked up at sea with part of a Boat and
41st Potatoes.

Tuesday 23

Thin 24 hours light winds and
pleasant weather the Labourer watch in
Liberty

Wednesday 24

S Watch on Liberty took off the
monition of our Potatoes a Boat load of
Flax

Thursday 25

Fine pleasant weather all hands
on board getting ready for sea &c

Friday 26

Clear weather and Light Air from
the Southward at 1 P.M. hoist short and broad
top sails at 4 got under way toward anchorage
&c Late 12.26 S Long 16.48 W
