

Ship Robt Edwards off Shore

Tuesday May 2nd 1837 Light breeze from the S.E. and clear steering by the wind to the Eastward all sail set

Wednesday 3 These 24 hours moderate trades carrying us sail bound in the fore - saw a ship

Thursday 4 Light winds from the S.E. and clear spoke the Emperors of Lisbon Lewis 11/2 m out 3 m middle part the sun later part caught a small sperm whale Day to the fore Late Long

Friday 5 First part finished cutting cleared the decks at day light commenced boiling so Ewas Late Long

Saturday 6 These 24 hours thick trades middle part finished boiling later part washed ship &c. Late Long

Sunday 7 Strong trades from the S.E. and pleasant steering by the wind to the Eastward carrying us sail Late Long

Monday 8 Clear pleasant weather steering to the Eastward Late Long

Tuesday 9 These 24 hours strong trades and pleasant steering by the wind to Eastward Late Long

Wednesday 10 First part light winds from the S by E and clear middle part strong Gale and thick weather later part saw the Land 20 m. Island of Calceopur Late Long

Thursday 11 Light winds from the E.S.E. and clear saw nothing steering by the wind inshore Late Long

Ship Robt Edwards bound inshore In Panama Bay

Friday 5th 12 1837 Light winds from the E.S.E. and pleasant middle and later part heavy Late Long for Port Long for up Long for Ob

Saturday 13 Steering to the Eastward under easy sail Top Gale Sailed hauld Late Long

Sunday 14 Strong Gale from the S.E. and Cloudy steering to the Eastward under easy sail Late Long

Monday 15 These 24 hours moderate winds thick weather saw nothing Course East Late Long

Tuesday 16 Light breeze from the S.W. and Cloudy steering East saw nothing Late Long

Wednesday 17 Thick weather Light winds at 30 minutes past 12 saw a large whale off our Larboard beam lowered away the boats in chase at 2 came on board the whale running fast to the windward Late Long

Thursday 18 Light winds from the Westward Cloudy middle and later part Light breeze from S.W. with rain steering by the wind on both Tacks Late Long

Friday 19 These 24 hours variable winds with rain saw nothing steering by the wind Late Long

Saturday 20 Light breeze attended with thunder Squalls steering to the Eastward Southward Late Long

Sunday 21 First part light breeze and Cloudy middle and later part rainy strong winds steering to the Southward Late Long
