sail &c Lat 16. 22 S

Saturday 12 Light breeze from the E S E and clear
middle part squally latter part the same &
heavy sea from the S E to E by S

Lat for Obs 19. 34

Long for Obs 116. 30

Sunday 13 Commenced with thick squally weather at
4 P.M. hauled top Gate sail and single reefed
top sails that drove the main royal yard and
main ship sail mast frequent squalls of rain with
heavy gusts of wind At 1 P.M. carried away
the Fly & Boom latter part employed at tacking
in and making sail set up the broad put shrouds

Lat for Obs 21. 39 South

Long for Obs 116. 10 West

Monday 14 First 24 hours commenced with light
strong breeze from the E S E and thick weather
heavy squally from the N E attended with rain
at 4 P.M. hauled morn. top Gate sail at 5 South
single top sails middle part showing heavy
at 11 P.M. hauled the main course and ship
ship beating 400 strokes an hour, latter part
morn moderate set the main sail, etc. Spun
turned out the masts and set the morn top Gate
sail rigging the pumps so as to make easy work

at 10 A.M. and Lat 22. 56 Point S E by E
hauled to the N E Long 115 57 West
