and Top Gull Studding sail Stowing Ely South  
middle part the same haden just Arr in the  
Lower studding sail at 9 A.M. saw a Bunch  
off our lee Mast off for it 2 hours 2 E 200  
Endy this day Late for Oct 2

Long for Ohio 100.21

Thursday 24 Commences with clear weather and  
starry Gales from the North at 2 P.M. took in  
Studding sails at 5 P.M. set Top Gull  
middle part blowing heavy later part wind  
increasing at 11 A.M. took in Top Gull  
and set the mainsail Ship heaving 300  
Studding for show Commenced Ely South  
Late 29. South  
No Observation

Friday 25 First part of this 24 hours blowing  
heavy from the NNE and rainy at 3 P.M.  
wind shifted to NW at 4 P.M. took in  
the mizzen of the Top Gull set the Main  
Top Gull sail set out the Studding sail  
below and aloft stowing Ely North middle  
part the same stowing Gales from the NNE and  
thick weather later falling main Top Gull to be  
to Endy this day Late 29.30

Saturday 26 First part of this 24 hours light Gales  
from NNE and pleasant at 4 P.M. under the  
Main Top Gull and set a new one Studding sails  
aloft and below

Late 29.34 South  
Long 92.30 West

Sunday August the 27<sup>th</sup> 1837

Commences with pleasant weather  
and few Gales from the N West stowing Ely South  
At 1/2 past 3 P.M. saw a school of sperm whales  
toward the boat the Starboard Boat fastened  
at 6 P.M. took him along side middle part  
they hoisted and clear At 6 A.M. commenced  
cutting and finished by 1/2 past 8 A.M. so Endy  
Late 29.37

Long 91.36

Monday 28 of August

Light winds from the North and West  
stowing Ely South by Compass sailing to middle part  
squally with rain later part light fair and pleasant  
at 10 P.M. Late 29.4 South

Long 90.33 West

Tuesday 29 of August

First part sailing to wind from  
the N West another weather stowing Ely South  
middle part at 2 P.M. wind calmed to the South  
South West some rain later part made and  
sail Studding sails below & aloft stowing Ely  
& with many winds from the N West

Late for Oct 29.30

Long for Ohio 88.00 West

Wednesday the 30 of 8 months

This 24 hours commences with  
strong winds from the S West and pleasant middle  
part blowing heavy from the S.W. with overcast weather  
later part single mizzen Top Gull at 10 A.M. set the  
main Top Gull sail over single mizzen Top Gull so Endy  
stowing Ely North Late for Oct 29.31  
stowing sails to the South West Long for Ohio 85.22 West
