and cloudy At 5 PM took in the stacking saily at 8
took in the ^{main} stacking for and mired Top Gale Saily
at 5 AM wind hauled to the S.W. and began to moderate
made sail moderate part light breeze and pleasant
later part fine weather so easy Lat 36.47

variable winds attended with calm middle part
wind hauled to the N.W. set the stacking Saily -
later part wind increasing Corred South

to the Westward took in the stacking Saily wind from
the S.W. ship close hauled to the Southward middle

untill the ship hit and part in the Storm

part wind more moderate at 6 AM wind ship to the

Saturday 17 Commenced with a strong breeze from
S.W. and cloudy with a heavy sea from the
West At 6 PM single uped Top Saily middle part
wind from the South West and moderate made all
sail steering upon a wind later part with Gale from
S.W. took in the for and mired Top Gale Saily so easy

the S.W. and cloudy middle part wind hauled to the
West by South and freshened at 5 PM hauled
the main Top Gale and doubled uped the Top Saily
later part wind from the Westward so easy
