Monday 16. Commenced with moderate S.W. breeze from the S.E. and clear middle and late part the same as having turning in the Noon Riggings Course N by E

Tuesday 17. of April Commenced with strong S.W. breeze from E.S.E. middle part light breeze latter part the same. fixing rigging gave a Ring

Lat. 3. 35 Long. 32. 15

Wednesday 18 first part strong winds from the S.E. and squally at 7 P.M. hauled the Sails Sails and Southwinds S.W. Sails and middle part light breeze from North made an sail course N.N.E. At 6 A.M. saw the Island of Ferdinand Noronho bearing E.N.E. dist 15 miles to the S.W. sailing Sails and hauled for it mid light with squally of rain fixing rigging and a Ship and a Brig starting to the Eastward

Thursday 19. first part light winds from the S.E. and rainy middle part light air and calm latter part the same Course North

Lat. 2. 46 Long. 32. 35

Friday 20. At 10 hours light air from the S.W. and pleasant at Noon fixing Ship &c turning North

Saturday 21. Thus 24 hours light air from S.W. and clear Course North

Wednesday 25. first part strong winds from E.N.E. and squally weather At 1 P.M. hauled in the Sails Sails and S.W. Sails and S.W. Sails at 5 moderate set for Sails Sails and S.W. Sails at 5 wind hauled to the S.E. and standing Sails middle part calm and squally latter part strong S.W. from the N.E. and overcast weather Long. 37. 33 Lat. 3. 17
