Commences with light air from
West S West and clear stowing S E engaged
shattering deck &c mialah and rather fast
light variable mialah

Lat by Obs 35° 03'

Long by Chron 26° 10' West

Saturday 1 of 11 Nov 1858

Commences with light breeze
from the Southward stowing by the mialah to the
Eastward mialah part light variable mialah
and rather fast the same

First part light Gale from S W
and a pleasant mialah and rather fast calm
stowing by the mialah to Southward

Monday 3 of 10 Nov 1858

First part light breeze from
S E and pleasant stowing by the mialah to
the S W with all sail set mialah part the
same rather fast saw two Frigs

Long by Chron 25° 15' W

Wednesday 4

Commences with light Gale
from S E and a pleasant stowing by the mialah
to S W at 2 P M backed to the Eastward saw a
Brig stowing N E

Lat by Obs 32° 23' N

Long by Chron 22° 57'

Thursday 5

Commences with light Gale from
S E and clear saw a sail to the Eastward
at 7 P M ship to the Westward at 9 P M
again to the Eastward mialah part weather
thick Lat part pleasant

Friday 6

First part light mialah from
S E pleasant mialah part mialah light and
baffling had a squall from the S West
rather fast the same stowing to the S and East
with all sail set
