

# Ship Robt Emarag for Harehuanag

Wednesday 17. of 10mo 1858

Commencing with light  
steady and pleasant at 1 P.M. a heavy squall  
from ESE made and rather fast wind light  
and variable from ESE & SE stirring by the wind  
to the south at 7 A.M. towed two boats for Black  
Fish caught 2 at two came on board and handed  
the ship by the wind to the East two sails in  
sight

Thursday 18

These 24 hours commenced with  
light breeze from SSE and thick weather  
stirring by the wind to the Eastward at 7 P.M.  
wind came to the Eastward became smooth  
and stood to the South Middle and rather  
fast light breeze from ESE and squally  
saw two ships and Trig

Friday 19

First part of these 24 hours light  
air and pleasant at 3 P.M. towed for Black  
Fish caught 2 at 6 came on board and made  
sail to S by E rather fast to the Black Fish

pleasant wind & course SSE at sail to the

clear middle part calm rather fast light breeze  
from ESE Course SSE

These 24 hours light variable winds  
and calms course SSE rather fast turning in  
the fore rigging

Tuesday 23

First part calm Noiaah part  
light air and pleasant rather fast light variable  
winds and rainy saw a sail

Lat by Obs 8. 58 North

Long by Chron 20. 26 West

Wednesday 24

First part light air from the N  
and heavy employed at sundown Noiaah  
part the same rather fast fresh ESE from  
N and a rainy stirring by the wind up to  
ESE

air and rainy Course S by E saw a ship and  
a Trig working to the Southward
