

Ship Boat Canara for Cape Horn

Friday 2. of November 1888

First part light variable wind
and rain middle part the same latter part
fresh wind from South steering upon a wind
up to N S West saw 2 different sails

Lat to Obs. } No Obs
Long to Chry }

Saturday 3 of November

Commenced with light wind from
the Southward & Eastward middle part
strong wind from the South steering N S W
occasionally squally with rain split the sky
latter part strong gale repairing 4 fire
saw one sail

Long to Chry 19. 13 14

Lat to Obs 4. 30 14

Sunday 4 First part strong wind from
S West attended with squalls of rain middle
and latter part the same fitting rigging &c

Lat to Obs 3. 27

Long to Chry 20. 23

Mon 5 First part strong wind from S S W
and pleasant saw white water and for it
saw no more of it middle part steering
to the Westward latter part back to the
South East at 8 A M backed again to
N S W so end squally

Tuesday 6 First part light N S W wind
some rain middle part clear steering S E
at 4 A M backed ship to the N S W then ship
in sight two steering to the North supposed
to be Whalers of the Lower Class bound home
to see those pretty girls W 3 H. 8
