

Ship Robt Edwards for Cape Horn

Friday 16th Nov 1838

These 24 hours fresh Gales from SE and pleasant at 7 AM finished boiling and made sail to the S by West

Lat 36° 06' N 111° 50' E

Long by Chron 36 12 W

Saturday 17th

Commencing with fresh breeze from East and pleasant all day clearing ship midday and latter part more moderate made at sail steering S by South passed a ship steering North by S

Lat 36° 06' N 113° 10' E

Long by Chron 36 06 W

Sunday 18th

These 24 hours strong Gales from the E N East and pleasant at 6 AM set making sail by course S by West

Lat 36° 06' N 115° 10' E

Long by Chron 33.13 W

Monday 19th Monday 19th

Commencing with strong Gales from N N E and pleasant steering S by S all day having employed steering down bit on the Larboard side of the Main Hatch way midday and latter part much the same

Tuesday 20th

These 24 hours strong breeze from North course S by S at 7 AM saw a shoal of sperm whales lowered and took one to the N by at Meridian took him along side and prepared for cutting

Wednesday 21st of November 1838

First part strong North by wind at 30 m from N began to cut and finished by S at 7 commenced boiling midday and latter part light breeze from the North and pleasant steering S by S in an easy sail

Lat 36° 06' N 119° 15' South

Long by Chron 36.46 West

Thursday 22nd These 24 hours brisk North by wind and clear at midnight finished boiling latter part all hands washing ship course S by S

Lat 36° 06' N 120° 57' E

Long by Chron 36.47 W

Friday 23rd These 24 hours strong North by wind with rain steering S by S all hands employed at ship's duty

Lat 36° 06' N 123° 07' E

Long by Chron 37.22 W

Saturday 24th The first part of these 24 hours strong Gales from N N W at 30 m PM saw whale lower but got nothing. midday part strong breeze light and weather the latter part so easy

Lat 36° 06' N 123° 32' South

Long by Chron 37.37 West

Sunday 25th first part strong breeze from the North midday and latter part light Gales and clear weather course S by S

Lat 36° 06' N 125° 41' E

Long by Chron 38.07 W

Monday 26th These 24 hours light Gales from the N by and clear weather course S by S put the bit between decks

Lat 36° 06' N 125° 12' E

Long by Chron 39.37 W
