

Ship Bobt Edwards for Yacuhuan

Thursday 13. of December 1858

Commencing with a strong Gale from S.W. lying too under a close reefed Main Topsail at 1 P.M. took in the M. Gout and turned up the Quarter Boats at 2 P.M. began to moderate commenced steering down and finished noon ship to the West with light Gale and pleasant but a heavy sea. Midday and latter part calm with a heavy swell from S.E. set whole Yopsail and Top Gals only all hands stowing down in the Main Mast

Long by Chng 47. 40. West

Friday 14. of December 1858

At 1 P.M. took a breeze from N.N.W. started S.W. by West all hands stowing down. Oil finished at 7 P.M. midday and latter part strong Gale cloudy clearing ship sent in the Fly. Lib. Toom. &c

Late P.M. by 59. 59. South

Long by Chng 51. 54. West

Saturday 15

First strong breeze from S.W. by W. and pleasant shortened sail to double reefed Yopsail Midday and latter part more moderate made sail accordingly employed mending Lib &c

Late P.M. by 60. 45. South

Long by Chng 51. 58. West

Sunday 16

Commenced with a strong breeze from West owing to N.N.W. increasing to a gale. At 3 P.M. hauled up the Yopsail at 7 put up Lib and Spanker Midday part light air and (Heavy) latter made sail again latter part wind increasing shortened sail again wind turning to the S.W. West

Bar and Weather Mast 1858

Monday 17. of December 1858

Commencing with a strong Gale from S.W. at 4 P.M. put up Fore and Main Yopsail and took in the main Boat but the main Yopsail and set it at 7 took in the Fore and Midday part a strong Gale lying too heading S.E. latter part more moderate set the Fore and Main Yopsails and Fousail noon ship to the N.N.W.

Long by Chng 51. 47. West

Tuesday 18

Commencing with a strong Gale from S.W. by S at 6 set down up the Yopsails Main sail Spanker and Lib Midday part wind turning to N.W. West made all sail stowing S.E. by the compass latter part strong Gale with heavy clouds and thick weather

Late P.M. by 42. 21. South

Long by Chng 53. 17. West

Wednesday 19

First part calm and strong Gale of wind from N.N.W. midday and latter part pleasant but a new Fore Top Gals sent stowing S.E. West

Late P.M. by 44. 11. South

Long by Chng 52. 13. West

Thursday 20

Began with gentle wind and pleasant from West. S.W. midday part wind S.W. turned to the West latter part wind from the Westward ship heading S.W. West

Late P.M. by 44. 30. South

Long by Chng 53. 28. West
