Tuesday 12. These 24 hours light breeze from S.E. and clear course N.W. by the land in sight getting the cutting wind

Wednesday 13

First part light winds and clear course N.W. by the tops of Mount Baker in sight. Midday part strong Gale from S.E. rather part wind the same but light course N.W. West

Sat by Ob 13. 27 Long by Chng 79. 20.

Thursday 14

Commenced with light Gale from S.E. and pleasant course N.W. without the main top Gale sail and mended midday part the same

Sat by Ob 11. 54. 9
Long by Chng 81. 50 West

Friday 15

First part strong winds from S.E. and pleasant course N.W. by the midday much the same rather part strong off N.W. by the sun plenty of Mount Baker Blackish

All these 24 hours light winds and pleasant course N.W. West. Direct Wind in abundance (fitting rigging &c)

Commenced with light air from S.E. and clear weather some course N.W. by a sail in sight

Thursday 21.

These 24 hours light Gale from S.E. and pleasant at 4 P.M. spoke the Peak of Mount Baker Allen 5 Montags out 15 N. by the latter part strong N.W. West
