All these 24 hours light Gale from SE and pleasant weather steering to the westward by different courses saw Flocks of Black Fish &c

These 24 hours fine Gale from South and pleasant steering to the westward At 11 AM made Hood's Island bearing AM dist 30 miles

Sunday 24

Land Galapagos

These 24 hours light Gale from SSE at 4 PM saw several large Scaues come ast to the Sennet supposed them to be Spanish Whales at 7 AM. But two boats on shore at Hood's Island after breakfast at Meridian ship lying off and on at the South Sea of the Island

Long by Log 89. 00 West

Monday 25

These 24 hours light Gale from SSE to S and pleasant at 4 PM the boats came off and brought a few small Peruvian mackerel and later steering to the westward at Meridian the South Head of Albemarle bore by S dist 40 miles

Late for Day 1. 24 South

Long by Log " " West

Tuesday 26

These 24 hours light Baffling mists and calms till 7 AM with the South Head of Albemarle bearing S dist 10 miles we took the boat and went on shore after breakfast at Meridian. Boat still on shore

Canal Howland Master 1859

Wednesday 27 of March

These 24 hours light Baffling mists and calms a ship in sight to the North at 5 PM Boat came off and brought 5 large Scaues and two small ones

Thursday 28

These 24 hours light Baffling mists and calms making the best of our way to the Bay at 10 AM spoke the Boy of Bristol or rather Warr 31. M. out 850 S. Capt Chas. Barton Esq. the Island of Harbogh bearing East 8 m dist

Friday 29

Commenced with light Baffling mists from SE and calms mackerel and rather part the same steering different courses in and about the Bay and the North Head of Albemarle the Boy of Warrington in company saw Fin. Back Bay Black Fish and Porpoises to end

Saturday 30

These 24 hours light Baffling mists and calms saw nothing the Boy in company At Meridian the North Head of Albemarle bore SSE dist 20 miles

Commenced with the Boy

Sunday 31

These 24 hours light variable mists and pleasant At 2 PM Capt came on board and started off PM mackerel and rather part making the best of our way to the SE West

Late for Day 0. 50 miles South

Long by Log 95. 14 West
