again the eastward latter part strong Gale
to East

Monday 8

First part of these 24 hours
strong wind and clear at 3 PM saw Whales
hauled and struck a whale to the Starboard
Boat  at 8 to 10 him along
side sun to very heavy lay by him during the
night latter commenced cutting at 11
AM saw sperm Whales going quick to
minarua and not near for them

Elwana Howland No after 1859

Monday 9. of Jan 1859.

First part finisha cutting
and bailed case at sunset back to
the SSE at 12 midnight back to the
SSW boiling & at 7 AM back again to
ESE squally with rain

Tuesday 11

First part of these 24 hours strong
wind and cloudy midday part the same
back to the SE latter part finisha boiling
boiling and washed off so easy

Lat by Obs 1. 57
Long by Chis No Obs

Wednesday 11.

Commence with strong wind
from SSE stirring & in union wind at sun
down blow for a school of sperm whales
but did not strike. Midday part latter
part commenced stowing down oil

Lat by Obs 1. 10 N
Long by Chis

Friday 12

Storing oil in the Hou Mola
at sun down back to the SE at day
light back again to the SSE at 10 AM
saw a school of sperm whales hauled
and chased

No Observations

Saturday 13 At 2 struck a whale
to the Starboard Boat at sunset took him
along side ship heading to the Eastward
Southwesterly midday part lay by the whale
latter part cut him in finisha by 8 AM
clean the deck Lat by Obs 1. 11 North
Long by Chis
