

Ship Robert Canary in Lacama

Sunday 19. of Jan 1859.

First part of these 24 hours fresh
Gale beating to minam and stor-
ing. At finish at sun down latter
part blowing off and setting up shocks
at 8 m. the rain 1 1/2 hours off the
harbour bow so easy Lat 5.7 N. M. 11
Long 81. 1. W

Monday 20

Commenced with moderate
wind from S.W. by S. Lacama bearing East
by N at 8 came to anchor in 4 1/2 fathoms
water latter part setting up shocks for water
on boat to the shore one working took off a
load of wood at Miriaian so easy

Tuesday 21

First part setting up shocks
on boat to the shore one working Miriaian
part preparing to go on shore latter
part arrived ship Phoenix Messery of San
tuckat so easy

Wednesday 22

Took our raft ashore
and filled it on boat to the shore trading
~~the~~ took off 1 boat load of wood latter part
after water so easy

Thursday 23

Took our raft along shore
howled it in latter part storing it away
on boat to the shore trading

Canara Howlana Maatua 1859.

Friday 24 of Jan 1859

Met on shore with
5 small canoes and left them on shore latter
took them off the capst gone up river at
Munting so easy

11 m. 12.50 day =
Saturday 25 void
took on shore a second
raft of canoes for water and returned

Saturday 26 27

First part towed off the capst
howled it in capst came off. Thove short
at 5 P.M. got underway and stood to sea
stowed our anchor and chain Miriaian part
storing by the wind to the N.W. main easy
said latter part the same meaning the S Boat

Lat by Ob 1.21 N
Long by Ob 81.10 W

Sunday 28

First part fresh Gale and heavy
storing to the N.W. West meaning the S Boat
finished her and set her on her cranes storing
to the N by E main easy said latter part main
said course N by E. 1/2 E

Lat by Ob 3.04
Long by Ob 81.20

Monday 29

First part of these 24 hours fresh
mings and clear storing E 1/2 S at sun down
shortened sail and heaved to by the wind
and now ship to the West main part
the same latter part storing by the wind
to the S + West and an all sail
