Tuesday 30 of 7 mo 1859

Commenced with strong winds and thick overcast weather stirring by the up to west at sunset shortened sail. Midday part rainy at daylight saw the Island of Mafelo bearing S by E 20 miles rather part rainy beating to minanara

Wednesday 31

Moderate S by from S West and rainy morning to minanara at Midday and Mafelo bore N E dist 10 miles

Thursday 1 of August 1859

These 24 hours moderate breeze from S West and rainy morning to minanara

Friday 2

These 24 hours moderate breeze from S by E to S by W and rainy stirring on opposite tack saw Mafelo bearing N E dist 20 miles

Saturday 3

Moderate breeze from S by W and a rainy morning to minanara slowly with all sail

Sunday 4 of 8 mo 1859

These 24 hours fine breeze from S by W and pleasant stirring by the wind up to N by W saw San Pedro and so forth

Monday 5

These 24 hours light breeze from S by W and cloudy stirring by the wind on opposite tack

First part light breeze from S by W and rainy midday part light baffling breeze rather part from S by West stirring to the westward

Wednesday 7

Light breeze from S by W and pleasant stirring by the wind to the westward

Long by Obs 85.30 W

Thursday 8

First part of these 24 hours a strong breeze and flowy from S to S by W stirring by the wind up to N by W making new Main (top) Galt Back Sails rather part split the fore stay
