First part strong winds from S and

SE and cloudy staring by the mind to the South
at 6 PM. light mind hacked to the ENE. at 9 Hacked

ESE to E staring by the mind up to SE.

Thursday 12

First part light winds from East
and pleasant staring by the mind SSE at 7 PM.
12 meridian saw whaling going quick to the mind
and lowered 3 boats and cleared until 3 PM
they came on board unbrist the Micaah sail and
but another mind and latter part the same.
at 11 AM saw now whaling lowered and caught
one to the S Boat at meridian cost him
by side the other boats stick off.

First part light winds and cal
m at 3 commenced cutting. finished at 3 PM.
waist Boat stuck Micaah and commenced towing
at 8 AM took him along side at daylight began
