daylight a Ship to the Navaroe whaling at the
clear our attention bore up and ran for her
at 8 AM hove to the SE. and struck at 11

the SE. again at 11 struck at midnight
him to ship the Magnolia Salmar hove to
4 Boats but was to take the ship to the hove
was the Cambria Bay of New Bedford
5 mos 300. 40 ends

Push trades and pleasant at 2
PM. began to put hove in the bores by sunset
lay by hove all night at daylight hove in the
bores at 7 AM saw more whales two Boats

still in chase

Friday 27 of December 1859

Strong mias and pleasant
boiling & chasing whales with two Boats at
1 PM the SE struck and drew at 2 she struck
again and saved him one of the Cambria's boats
pastured to him formed his mast and cut
thy sperm whales caught one. cut in our
whale an star to PM

spoke the Logan Buggs of New Bedford 20 mos out
700 Tons.

Tuesday 31.

Moderate mias from SE and plea
sant at 1 PM saw whales hove to and struck two
on to the SE. & one to the Waist Boat at 3 had them
alongside lay by them all night rather part cut
them in a shoal of whales passed us going quick
to the N.W. 40 ends
