Sunday 12. of January 1840

Strong trade and pleasant
stirring by the wind four ships in sight

Lat $\frac{p}{m}$ 12.50 P

Long by Chron 85.15 W

Monday 13

Fine weather stirring by the wind
rather fast breaking out the ground fire in the aft
Mola on the starboard side and cooping it.
{saw a whale shoot} Lat $\frac{p}{m}$ 13.06.
twice Long by Chron 85.50

Tuesday 14

Light winds and pleasant and
at 1 P.M. saw a large whale going quick to
the N.E. lowered 3 boats and struck him to
the larboard boat. at 4 took him along side
and a deck fast stowed off the Mola an chara deck
&c. at daylight began to cut finished by 12.

Wednesday 15

Light winds and pleasant
chased the wreck and began to boil at 2 P.M.
our ship in sight to minarua latter part two
in sight

Strong winds and heavy all hands
employed at sailing &c. stirring by the wind to
the N.E. so early

Strong winds and some rain
at 1 P.M. finished boiling stirring by wind

Saturday 18.

Strong trade and heavy weather
rather fast caught two Blackfish so early

Lat $\frac{p}{m}$ 12.41 South

Long by Chron 85.50 West

Sunday 19.

Strong S.E. trade and muggy wea-
ther at 5 P.M. saw a shoot of sperm whale
going quick to minarua towards and Chasia
(but no catch him)

Monday 20.

Strong winds and heavy heading
to the E.N.E. under double reefed topsails

Lat $\frac{p}{m}$ 12.01. P

Tuesday 21.

Strong trade winds and cloudy
rather fast two ships at 11 saw whale going
quick to minarua towards and Chasia boats came on
board minus whale

Wednesday 22.

Strong trade and cloudy mudd-
ing the sparker stirring by the wind to the South
