Saturday 8 of February 1840

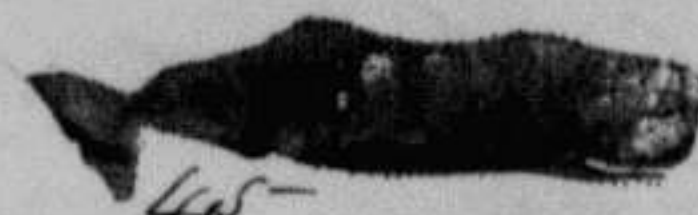
Light trades and pleasant weather
