Monday 2

Fine weather the I Watch on Liberty
took off 40 bbls of water blacked the buoys &c
at 6 PM arrived Barge Isaac Ray of Santhearn
Tuesday 3

Pleasant weather the Garrison Watch
on Liberty the watch on board employed stowing
water painting Ship getting off sand &c.
Wednesday 4.

Clear weather the I Watch on Liberty
the watch on duty employed getting off Mags &
Sunday other jobs

Thursday 5

Fine weather and light mms the
I Watch on Liberty took off 20 bbls of Potatoes
&c.

Friday 6

Pleasant weather the I Watch on Liberty
nothing particular going on - Sunday

Saturday 7

All hands on board getting ready
for sea Shipped Alfred Sanders Cook George
McC. Neal Mm. Moon John Burtin in place of
Wapichouse Cooks, Abraham Phis Isaac Eames
discharged Antonio discharged

Canard Howland Modest 1840

Sunday 8 of March 1840

Light mms from 9 and pleasant
at 9 PM got underway and stood out of the Harbour
Stowed anchors chased the DECK &c at 7 PM St
Lorenzo bon PE mms from PE showing South
met with all sail set rather fast strong mms from
PE showing N P M. took in the Pop. Galt-Sails
so ended this 12 hours Lat. 41. 12. 17. S.

Long by Chig 78. 55 M

Monday 9. Strong trade and heavy mms
at 2 PM double reefed the Topsails at 3 pushed
the Main sail and Mr. Gipsair at 6 PM spoke the
Magalia with 900 and the George Brewster of Ston-
ington 500 Spm 900 Whale 15 mos out at 7 PM
shorted off West

Lat. 41. 14. 44

Long by Chig 80. 50

Tuesday 10. Strong mms from PE. showing West
spoke the George again ahead sent 5 mly S
rather fast course West in an hour ahead spoke

Lat. 41. 11. 54.

Long by Chig 81. 50

Wednesday 11.

Most part of this 24 hours strong
West by S and at 10 PM rather fast strong mms
ran up jobs and dumpy

Lat. 41. 11. 51

Long by Chig 83. 17.

Thursday 12. Light mms and clear a 1/2 past
5 PM saw a shoal of sperm whales going quick
to the George lowered and missed until dark
then came on board made fast lying with the
Main Gipsair to the Mast rather fast steered off
at 11 saw the George and plenty of sperm whales

Fastened the I & J Boat and drew the
I & J Store so as (Boat)
