

Ship Robert E. Amara for the Galapagos

Friday 13 of March 1840

First part calm and pleasant at 7 P.M. took a light breeze from E. made and latter part drove I with all sail etc.

Lat. 1° 03' — Long by Chron.

Saturday 14

Light mias and clear weather. Staring to the Westward. Lat. 1° 03' 12.49. S Long by Chron. 86.31 W

Sunday 15 First light mias and pleasant. Staring N.W. made fresh fresh mias started N.W. rather mild and weather much the same. Lat. 1° 03' 11.27. S Long by Chron. 86.44 W

Monday 16 Light mias from E. and pleasant. Staring to the N.W. saw Glacé Fish etc. Lat. 1° 03' 9.41 S Long by Chron. 86.46 W

Tuesday 17 Moderate mias and pleasant. Staring N.W. Spoke the Group of Stinkington Mias. First started ~~to~~ to the N.E. under easy sail. Latter part started N.W. Lat. 1° 03' 8.40 S Long by Chron. 86.30 W

Wednesday 18 Fresh mias and hazy weather. At 3 P.M. saw a school of Spermacean Whales. Lowered at 4 the L.B. smoke and got stove the same. At 6 the L.B. fastened at anchor. Came on board Shortland sail and started by the wind to the Southward at 2 A.M. came to with the Main topsail to the West. Latter part coming by the wind. Lat. 1° 03' 8.40 S Long by Chron. 87.30 W

Thursday 19 Fresh mias and pleasant. First made part covered by the wind. Latter part started off N.W. with everything out. Lat. 1° 03' 8.20 S Long by Chron. 87.20 W

Islands E. Amara Mountain Master 1840

Friday 20 of March 1840

Light mias and pleasant weather. Staring to the N.E. Latter part staring North.

Lat. 1° 03' 7.58 South Long by Chron. 86.04 West

Saturday 21

First part Baffling mias with some rain. Midday part Shortland sail and came to with the Main topsail aback. Latter part making the four sail saw Glacé Fish. Lowered and caught 3 so was.

Lat. 1° 03' 7.00 S Long by Chron. 85.40 W

Sunday 22 First part light mias and pleasant. Staring N.W. finished the four sail and built it. Midday and latter part mild from N.E. hearing N.W.

Lat. 1° 03' 6.15 S Long by Chron. 86.15 W

Monday 23 Light baffling mias. Staring to the Westward. Going Glacé Fish. Lat. 1° 03' 5.55 S Long by Chron. 86.50 W

Tuesday 24 Light variable mias from N.E. to S.E. Staring to the Westward. Made part sunny. Lat. 1° 03' 4.58 S Long by Chron. 86.48 W

Wednesday 25 Light mias from E. Staring N.W. E. so was. Lat. 1° 03' 3.28 S Long by Chron. 86.55 W

Thursday 26 Light mias from E. to S.E. Staring to the North. Lat. 1° 03' 2.20 S Long by Chron. 86.45 W

Friday 27 Light mias from S.E. and clear. Started off N.W. Midday and latter part Staring N.W. Lat. 1° 03' 1.19 S Long by Chron. 87.05 W
