Strong Easly winds and  
raining took in sail to a close reefed main top  
sail and foresail heading Southwesterly  
No Ob

Thursday 5

First and much part strong  
SE winds and raining under a close reefed  
Main top sail and foresail rather part  
moderate winds from NW and pleasant  
made all sail
