

Ship Robt Camas for Valparaiso

Saturday 12.

First part, morning
and pleasant weather sailing in for the
land at 2 hours ^{saw} Conception Pape
also at 4 hours bearing ESE 25 miles
at 6 PM but the cables at 7 PM took in studd-
ing sails much part nearly calm at 9
hours AM passed the Point of Quirigua
and commenced beating up the Harbour
in company with a Targue so ended

Sunday 13

Strong breeze at 2 PM came
to anchor in Valparaiso Roads in 5
fathoms of water found the ship Wm Lee
Gifford of New York 5 mos out no oil the Pan-
ama of Sag Harbour full bound home the
John Wells New York New York and a man-
o-war schooner Chilano

Monday 14.

Fine weather the Harbour
match on Liberty later part employed
at painting ship and so forth

Tuesday 15

Fine weather all hands employ-
ed at painting ship and so

Wednesday 16

The Harbour match on
Liberty the match on board engaged at
Sunday jobs so ended sailed ship John
Wells on a 3 mos cruise from thence home

starting Passa the PM match on Liberty

Pleasant got off 10 Bbls of

Liberty so ended

Monday 21.

Pleasant weather got off 7 casks
of water at 4 PM. arrived ship Hullion bound
of and for New Zealand with 3000 Bbls of oil
direct from New Zealand

Tuesday 22.

Fine weather took on board 20
Bbl Potatoes also 4 of Onions and 4 hogs
sailed the Wm Lee on a cruise bound to the
Command
