

Ship Robt E Amaras for Cape the

Thursday 14. of January 1841.

Commenced with strong NW winds
Course NE by N ships in the close reefed fore
and Mr Topsails and whole Main Top sail
middle part more moderate wind from West
made all sail rather part fresh minas from
W N and on east

Lat for Obg 54. 54 S
Long by Chron 60. 10 W

Friday 15

Commenced with fresh breeze from
West and cloudy course NE. Minak part more
exalt minas from NW set standing sails
rather part strong minas and squally took in
Top G & Lower Studding Course NE by N single
up the Topsails and set the Main Gale on
the Main Topsail at 6 AM saw one of the
Dutch Islands bearing E by N. 15 miles

Long by Chron 57. 56 W

Saturday 16. Commenced with fresh minas
from NW and squally at 6 PM set Top Gale standing
9 sails middle part moderate minas from
W by N made sail rather part much the
same course NE by N

Lat for Obg 50. 56 S
Long by Chron 53. 55 W

Sunday 17.

Commenced with moderate
minas from NW and pleasant course NE by N
middle part moderate the same wind veering
to the N and on east latter part minas from
N. W course NE by N took in standing sails
brought up sharp

Lat for Obg 48. 48 S
Long by Chron 52. 52 W

United States E Amara Mouraria Nostrum

Monday 18 of January 1841

First part strong minas from NW
by N at 1 PM hauled Top Gale Pails and drove
up the Topsails at 3 PM set single up the Top
sails Course NE by N some rainy at 7 PM minas
still veering to the Westward at 10 PM Top Gale
sails of single up the Topsails at 2 AM minas
from NW made all sail standing sails below
and aloft rather part the same fitting the boat
for whaling so was

Lat for Obg 47. 25 S
Long by Chron 45. 28 W

Tuesday 19. First part of these 24 hours strong
minas and pleasant steering NE by N Minak
part the same SPM minas rather part nearly
calm minas veering to the N E & C. some

Lat for Obg 45. 48 S
Long by Chron 47. 24 W

Wednesday 20.

First part of these 24 hours
light minas making no headway middle
part a light minas from NW steering by
the minas up to NE by N latter part strong minas
took in the fore & Mr Top Gale sails so much heading
to E

Lat for Obg 45. 17 S
Lat for Chron 45. 56 W

Thursday 21.

First part of these 24 hours
strong minas from NW steering by the minas
up to the NE by N at 6 PM set the fore and
Main Top Gale sails middle & rather part minas from
South & East steering NE by N standing sails
below and aloft at 10 AM took in the lower
standing sails minas from NE by South
