Wednesday 17.

Fresh N. E. winds and
pleasant the water came off in a launch
took off some fruit &c. the Brig Susan
59 days from New York touched here bound
to Rio de Janeiro one of the Brazilian Fleet
may arrive from the minas soon.

Thursday 18.

Fresh N. E. winds Capt. & Mr.
on shore the crew getting off fruit &c.
at 11 P.M. a small ship crew of 12 men
arrived 19th Br. ship lit laying off and
on to get some provisions 80 days from Salva-
dore. At 7 A.M. the Saca got underway
and stood off shore our boat on shore
at 9 A.M. the boat and main sail were taken
our anchor capsized at the Mendez's Fall.
Capt. went on shore after a launch to take
the anchor while he was gone succeeded
in getting it ^{with} running at 12 Meridian got
underway at 2 P.M.

Friday 19 At 2 P.M. Capt. came on board
and made all sail the Saca standing
in shore at 3 P.M. Saca tacked off shore
at 11 spoke her and gave a with her
mischief sail mine going to the Eastward
at 12 made light tacked ship to the N. E.
rather fast the same several miles in sight
passed and English ships of war

Sunday 21.

Commenced with fresh winds
from E by S and pleasant course N. E.
mischief sail blowing strong at 10 A.M. the
in standing still course N. at 12 A.M. set
them again the Saca just in sight ahead

Long by Chron 34.49 N.

Monday 22.

First sail strong winds and
pleasant course N. mischief sail the same
rather painting ship inside 80 days
Lat 10 S. 10
Long by Chron 35.19 N.

Tuesday 23.

Commenced with light E. winds
and pleasant painting inside course North
mischief sail the same standing N. E. by compass
rather fast painting ship inside 80 days
saw a Brig in the west Lat 10 S. 10
Strong North by
Long by Chron 35.41 N.

Wednesday 24.

Light E by S winds all hands
idle waiting for faint to any course N. E. 4th
mischief sail calm nearly rather fast the same
having ahead stuff 80 days a Brig in
sight Lat 10 S. 10
