Strong winds from N^W
with a heavy swell on ship,
heading different courses, so ends

Tot 36-33, S.
Sun, 21-12, W.

Wednesday, Dec. 23rd
Strong winds from
N. W. ship steering N. E. and S. E.
so ends this day.

Tot, 36-23, S.
Sun, 20-24, W.

Thursday, Dec. 24th
First part
moderate, latter part very light
N. E. W. winds, so ends.

Tot, 36-13, S.
Sun 20-48, W.

Friday, Dec. 25th
light air and calms
put out a few boats, so ends

Tot 36-06
Sun, 20-46.

Saturday, Dec. 26th
Moderate winds
from the N. N. E. steering
different courses, so ends this day

Tot, 36-15, S.
Sun, 21-42, W.

Board the Ship, Robert Edwards. N^o 13
1863

Sunday, Dec. 27th
Fresh breeze from
the N. and heavy at 12 M. wind
bowed to the W. and died out
took in sail as usual, so ends this day

Tot, 36-36-5
Sun, 22-49, W.

Monday, Dec. 28th
light winds from
the East S. E. took in sail so ends

Tot, 36-29, S.
Sun, 23-26, W.

Tuesday, Dec. 29th
First part light
winds from the N. steering E. and
N. E. latter part rain, wind the same

Wednesday, Dec. 30th
Winds moderate and
fading from N. E. to W. thick
fog at times, so ends

Tot, 36-27, S.
Sun, 22-33, W.

Thursday, Jan. 1st
light and variable
winds, thick fog until 2 P. M. it
let up ship steering different
courses so ends this day

Tot, 36-35, S.
Sun, 21-31, W.
