Moderate Winds
from N.E. steering E.S.E.
50 ends. Lat. 40° 00' S
Lon. 56° 00' E.

Moderate winds
from N. and N.W. steering E.S.E.

light and baffling winds
and calms, for the last four days
have had a light southerly wind,
50 ends. Lat. 38° 18' S.
Lon. 75° 43' E.

Sunday April 3. rd
light winds from the N.W.
steering E.S.E. at 7 A.M. sighted
the Island of St Pauls, in the
Lat. 38° 45' S, Lon. 74° 36' E, sent two
boats in fishing went on shore, got 14 bush
potatoes, there is a fishing party from
the Isle of, Borbon, here that do a good
business in the fishing line, at time they
employ 40 men, at present there are but 3
men here, got 4 bl. fis. and greater quantity
of crabs fish, left at dark steering
E by S, 50 ends

Monday, April. 4. th
moderate winds from
the N.W. steering E by S, two
sail in sight steering in the E.
50 ends. Lat. 38° 33'

Fresh Breeze
from the N.W. latter part steering
