ployed in mending fore sail
shorten sail at dark. So Ends

S.W. & W. S.W. at 7 a.m.
raised a sperm whale going
quick to S. Lowerd 3. Boat
2 at 8. 1 at 40 p.m. Bark Kinnaird

boats at 11 a.m. at 4 p.m. galled the whale
boats come on board at 6 p.m. no whale
