Moderate winds from S. at 8. A.M. saw a large sperm Whale going quick to windward lowered for him without success, saw a sail to leeward, at dark shorten sail. so ends

Wednesday, June, 21st

Strong winds from the N. with rain ship on different tack. so ends.

Thursday, June, 22nd

Moderate gales from S.W. ship under close reef main top sail. so ends

Sat 44-10. CS

Friday, June, 23rd

Light winds from

S.W. and N.W. ship steering different courses at dark shorten sail. so ends

Saturday June, 24th

Strong winds from N.W. and thick weather ship heading different courses shorten sail at dark so ends.

Sunday, June, 25th

Strong winds from N.W. & squally weather ship heading different courses so ends

Monday June 26th



Moderate winds from W. and N.W. with dirty weather at 4. P.M. saw a sperm whale in company with the Annamede, lowered without success, Whale going quick to windward at 6. short the Annamede, so ends

Tuesday June 27th

Moderate gales from S.W. at 9. A.M. put off to the Northward being bad weather and few Whales, here this season
