

Abstract of a Whaling Voyage

Friday, July 7th

Fresh Breeze from S. ship steering N. passed Balls perimed and run down by the E. side of the Island and hauled up under the N. head and stood off to the N.ward so ends

Saturday July 8th

Fresh Breeze from S.E. at 10 A.M. went on shore landed on the N. side Horns Isle, at 3 P.M. landed a raft for water, sent off some potatoes. so ends

Sunday, July 9th

at day light sent off the raft of water at 3 P.M. took off a raft of potatoes, wind strong from E. so ends

Monday July 10th

Strong winds from N.E. laid Dis 20 m ship working up Cap Nichols on board so ends

in ship Robert Edwards of M.B. 185

Tuesday July 11th

First part moderate wind from N. at 10 A.M. heavy squall from N.W. took in sail to close reef top sail, & fore sail at 2 P.M. wind moderated went on shore with the boat for potatoes wind came in strong from the N. ship stood off so ends

Wednesday 12th

at 8 A.M. ship bore in sight to the S. having bin off E. days in a heavy gale, took off three Boat loads of potatoes and bags one boat from shore came off loaded so ends

Thursday July 20th

at 3 P.M. capt off to the Enard, with a moderate breeze from S. S. S.C. got a set of sight. ship 6 m. E. at dark steering N. round to caters banks so ends

Friday July 21st
light winds from S. S. S.W. steering N. so ends
