Sunday May 20th
All this day, moderate gales, N.E.
heavy rain, so ends

Monday May 21st
Moderate gales, N.E., rain,
so ends.

Tuesday May 22nd
Strong Winds, N. Gatta part
N.W. Cloudy, started to boil
at 10. A.M. Wind S.W. ship
heading N.W. so ends.

Wednesday May 22nd
Weather fine & Clear, ship
steering N.E. all hands employed
in boiling, so ends.

Thursday May 23rd
Moderate winds, N. squally
all hands employed in boiling
so ends

Ship Robert Edwards, N.E. 2/869

Friday May 24th
Moderate gales, N.E.,
squally, finish boiling, so ends
Lat 43-53

Saturday May 25th
Strong Wind, S.
Weather clear, all hands employed
in stowing down, finish at dark
so ends. Lat 43-57 S.
Lon 166-03 W.

Saturday June 2nd

All this day, light
Winds and Calm. Barque Flying.
Childers in sight at 8. It was raised
sperm whales close to the Childers.
lowered three Boats. Childers Boats
struck same time. shortly after
lost his whale. Barque Monama^{de}
lowered four boats. Casarist untill
dark. Boats came on board without
success. so ends. Lat 43-32
