Wednesday

May 19th First of these 24 hours strong breeze from S.W. B.H. steering E by N hands employed setting up head stays at dark shortened sail mid & latter parts cloudy weather so ends this day no Ob.
Joseph Sherman remains much the same

Thursday

May 20th First of these 24 hours thick rainy weather & variable winds saw one sail at dark shortened sail mid & latter parts strong N.E. winds saw a steamer so ends this day Lat 35.01 Long 55.22

Friday

May 21st First of these 24 hours fine weather & strong breeze from N.E. B.H. steering by the wind saw several sail at dark shortened sail mid & latter parts weather much the same so ends this day
Lat 34.48 Long 55.18

Saturday

May 22nd First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & a strong breeze from the Eastward B.H. steering by the wind at dark shortened sail mid & latter parts weather much the same so ends this day Joseph Sherman remains the same
Lat 34.15 Long 54.40

Sunday

May 23rd First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & a strong breeze from the N.E. hands employed in different jobs about decks while at work scraping a spar for found it to be rotten saved it up mid & latter parts fine weather so ends this day Lat 33.54 Long 54.33

Monday

May 24th First of these 24 hours fine weather & Easterly wind B.H. steering by the wind at dark shortened sail mid and latter parts much rain so ends this day
Lat 34.18 Long 54.42

May 25th First of these 24 hours fine weather & variable winds B.H. under all sail steering E & E at dark shortened sail & luffed to the wind mid & latter parts fine weather set up fore rigging to day so ends this day Lat 34.08 Long 54.11

May 26th First of these 24 hours fine weather & light N.E. wind B.H. steering E & E saw one sail set up main rigging to day at dark shortened sail mid & latter parts squally weather so ends Lat 34.16 Long 54.11

Thursday

May 27th First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & strong westerly winds with frequent showers saw one sail to day at dark shortened sail mid & latter parts weather much the same so ends Lat 32.32 Long 54.39

Friday

May 28th First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & a strong breeze from the Northward B.H. steering S at dark shortened sail mid & latter parts fine weather so ends this day Lat 30.50 Long 54.28

Saturday

May 29th First of these 24 hours fine weather & light Northwardly wind B.H. steering different courses mid & latter parts weather much the same so ends this day Lat 29.41 Long 54.21

Sunday

May 30th First of these 24 hours fine weather & light Northwardly wind B.H. steering S & E hands employed setting up rigging saw one sail at dark shortened sail mid & latter parts weather much the same one sail in sight our sick board Joseph Sherman remains much the same so ends Lat 29.20 Long 54.08
