Monday

May 31st

First of these 24 hours fine weather & light Northward by wind B H steering different courses 3 sail in sight boarded ship Haranack of New York 29 days from Bonard bound to Philadelphia at dark shortened sail mid & latter parts the same so ends this day

Tuesday

June 1st

First of these 24 hours fine weather & Northward by wind B H steering by the wind saw a steamer & 2 sail at dark shortened sail mid & latter parts weather much the same so ends Lat 28.58 Long 52.37

Wednesday

June 2nd

First of these 24 hours fine weather & moderate breeze from N E B H steering by the wind hands employed in various jobs about decks mid & latter parts the same so ends Lat 29.32 Long 51

Thursday

June 3rd

First of these 24 hours fine weather & light N E wind B H steering by the wind lowered Boat & picked up a bbl of Palm oil as we suppose at dark shortened sail mid & latter parts the same one sail in sight so ends this day Lat 29.50 Long 51.29

Friday

June 4th

First of these 24 hours fine weather & light air from N E B H steering different courses gained with B H & E B Phillips Capt. Francis mid & latter parts calm so ends this day Lat 29.55

Saturday

June 5th

First of these 24 hours fine weather & light variable wind gained with B H & E B Phillips & got 2 Mers from her mid & latter parts weather much the same lowered the Boats for Alfjrens but did not get any so ends this day Lat 30.05 Long 53.36

June 6th

First of these 24 hours fine weather and a light breeze from N W B H steering by the wind mid & latter parts strong breeze spoke & gained with Brig D. A Small of Provincetown Capt. Curran so ends this day Lat 30.47 Long 52.38

Monday

June 7th

First of these 24 hours squally weather finished gaming at 10 o'clock mid & latter parts light & variable winds hands employed in bracking out & cooping oil our sick. Men & Joseph Rherman remains the same so ends this day no obs

Tuesday

June 8th

First of these 24 hours fine weather & light winds from the Eastward B H steering N by W finished cooping our oil at 3 P.M. at dark shortened sail mid & latter parts the same saw one sail to day Lat 31.20 Long 52.18

Wednesday

June 9th

First of these 24 hours fine weather & light westerly wind B H steering N by W saw 2 mers & Porpoises mid & latter parts strong breeze so ends Lat 33.00 Long 53.04

Thursday

June 10th

First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & a strong breeze from the Westward B H steering N by W at dark shortened sail mid part fine weather latter part strong breeze saw Porpoises to day so ends Lat 34.28 Long 53.52

Friday

June 11th

First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & a strong breeze from N W B H steering by the wind at dark shortened sail mid & latter parts the same so ends Lat 35.02 Long 54.34
