Saturday

June 12th. First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & variable winds with passing showers at dark shortened sail mid & latter parts fine weather saw Frampusses to day so ends Lat 34.34 Long 54.57

Sunday

June 13th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & moderate breeze from the westward picked up a large stick of timber to day also saw Porpoises at dark shortened sail mid & latter parts strong breeze from N W saw one sail so ends Lat 34.32

Monday

June 14th. First of these 24 hours blowing fresh from S W with much rain saw Frampusses mid & latter parts thick haze weather so ends this day Lat 35.06 Long 55.20

Tuesday

June 15th. First of these 24 hours thick weather & fresh gale from N W dark under 2 close reefed topsails steering by the wind mid & latter parts the same so ends this day Lat 35.33 Long 55.28

Wednesday

June 16th. First of these 24 hours hazy weather & strong breeze from the westward R H steering by the wind saw 2 schools of Porpoises mid & latter parts thick & raining Joseph Sherman remains much the same so ends this day no obs

Thursday

June 17th. First of these 24 hours blowing fresh from the westward with much rain saw one sail steering to the Northward mid & latter parts weather more moderate hands employed breaking out so ends this day Lat 34.32 Long 54.47

June 18th. First of these 24 hours hazy weather & a fresh breeze from S W R H steering by the wind at dark shortened sail mid & latter parts fine weather saw Blackfish to day & lowered for them but did not get on so ends this day Lat 34.26 Long 54.35

Saturday

June 19th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & moderate breeze from S W R H steering by the wind at night shortened sail mid & latter parts the same Lewis Parker off duty sick so ends this day Lat 34.25 Long 54.21

Sunday

June 20th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light S W wind R H steering different courses spoke & gained with R H. Palmetto Capt. Snipp at dark shortened sail mid & latter parts weather the same saw Blackfish lowered for them but did not get on 2 sail in sight so ends Lat 34.23 Long 54.23

Monday

June 21st. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light S W winds R H steering by the wind 2 sail in sight at night shortened sail mid & latter parts weather the same saw 2 sail Lewis Parker & Joseph Sherman off duty sick so ends this day Lat 34.31 Long 53.36

Tuesday

June 22nd. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light S W wind R H steering different courses saw Porpoises & 2 sail at dark shortened sail mid & latter parts strong breeze saw several sail so ends this day Lat 35.02 Long 52.14
