Sunday

Aug 15th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & S.W. wind
B.K. steering E 1/2 S mid & latter parts wind from
the westward saw 4 crampusses so ends this day
Lat 38.17 Long 36.03

Monday

August 16th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & westerly
wind B.K. steering E 1/2 S mid & latter parts
Northardly winds so ends this day
Lat 38.31 Long 34.17

Tuesday

Aug 17th. First of these 24 hours strong Easterly winds with
passing squalls B.K. steering by the wind saw Porpoises
saw tea mer steering to the westward also saw part of
a wreck & saw Iron Coal Buoy mid & latter parts the same
let Charles Smith out of Irons & he went on duty
to day Lat 37.38 Long 33.52

Wednesday

Aug 18th. First of these 24 hours strong Easterly wind
B.K. steering by the wind on port tack mid & latter
parts the same so ends Lat 36.57 Long 32.02

Thursday

Aug 19th. First of these 24 hours strong N.E. winds with
frequent squalls B.K. steering by the wind
mid & latter parts weather much the same so ends
Lat 36.40 Long 31.06 John Decoste

Friday

Aug 20th. First of these 24 hours strong N.E. winds B.K. steering
by the wind on port tack mid & latter parts the same
saw Porpoises & got one so ends this day
Lat 36.22 Long 29.57

Saturday

Aug 21st. First of these 24 hours hazy weather & strong breezes
from N.E. B.K. steering by the wind mid & latter parts
the same so ends this day Lat 36.26 Long 29.34

Sunday

Aug 22nd. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light N.E. wind B.K.
steering by the wind on different tacks mid part the same
latter part variable wind with frequent squalls
so ends this day Lat 36.43 Long 29.14

Monday

Aug 23rd. First of these 24 hours fine weather & N.E. wind
B.K. steering by the wind on starboard tack mid
latter parts the same so ends this day
Lat 37.04 Long 29.34

Tuesday

Aug 24th. First of these 24 hours fine weather light N.E. winds
& calms lowered the boats after 4 P.M. to practice the
wood in pulling mid part the same latter part
moderate breeze from W.W.W. B.K. steering N.E.
saw one sail so ends this day
Lat 37.36 Long 29.15

Wednesday

Aug 25th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & a moderate
breeze from W.W.W. B.K. steering N.E. saw 4 sail
also saw a school of Crampusses mid & latter
parts the same at 11 hours Am raised Pico bearing
E by N so ends this day Lat 38.34 Long 28.01

Thursday

Aug 26th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & a strong
breeze from the westward B.K. steering E by N
at 6 hours P.M. luffed to the wind Day all was
bearing E by E at dark distant 10 miles also saw
a sail mid & latter parts hazy at 5 hours Am raised
the lead kept ship off & ran in to Fayal & dropped
Anchor in 18 fathoms water
