

Remarks on board B.H.

Sunday

Sept 19th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light variable winds B.H. steering off on mid & latter parts weather the same land in sight all day also saw 3 sail so ends this day Lat 38.18 Long 28.56

Monday

Sept 20th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light variable winds B.H. steering by the wind heading in towards the land mid & latter parts raining so ends this day

Tuesday

Sept 21st. First of these 24 hours fine weather & a strong breeze from the Southward B.H. steering off on the Capt came on board at 3 P.M. Manuel Thomas one of our Boatmen who has been on shore for a few days with his folks failed to be down to the Boat at the appointed time so we came off & left him mid & latter parts thick haze weather and a strong breeze from S.W. so ends this day Lat 38.33 Long 29.42

Wednesday

Sept 22nd. First of these 24 hours blowing fresh from S.W. B.H. steering by the wind on port tack at night shortened sail & made things snug mid & latter parts blowing a gale so ends this day Lat 38.30 Long 29.55

Thursday

Sept 23rd. First of these 24 hours pouring hard from the westward B.H. steering by the wind on port tack mid & latter parts wind halled to Northward B.H. steering S. so ends Lat 27.16 Long 28.50

Sept 24th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & a moderate breeze from the Northward B.H. steering S by E mid & latter parts light winds hands employed setting up rigging so ends this day Lat 36.36

Saturday

Sept 25th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light winds from the Northward B.H. steering S by E finished setting up main rigging to day mid & latter parts weather much the same so ends this day Lat 35.46 Long 27.30

Sunday

Sept 26th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light W. winds B.H. steering S by E hands employed setting up rigging mid & latter parts variable winds Joseph & Thomas and Jo. Lopes off duty sick

Monday

Sept 27th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light variable winds B.H. steering by the wind mid & latter parts strong breezes saw one sail to day so ends this day Lat 34.28 Long 25.32

Tuesday

Sept 28th. First of these 24 hours cloudy weather and a strong breeze from the Southward B.H. steering by the wind saw 3 sail & 2 Finbacks to day mid & latter parts weather much the same saw no other sail and a Finback so ends this day Lat 34.27 Long 23.52

Wednesday

Sept 29th. First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & a strong breeze from the Southward B.H. steering by the wind mid & latter parts frequent squalls of wind & rain so ends this day no Obs
