

Remarks Onboard B.H.

Wednesday

Oct 13th. First of these 24 hours fine weather and a moderate breeze from N.E. B.H. steering S.W. by S saw one sail mid & latter parts hazy at 7. Am raised the Island of St. Nicholas into ahead also saw Blackfish so ends this day Lat 16.30 Long 23.46

Thursday

Oct 14th. First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & heavy squalls of wind & rain from different parts of the Compass mid & latter parts calm so ends this day Joseph Hermann & Jo. Seopes off duty early Lat 15.32

Friday

Oct 15th. First of these 24 hours hazy weather & a light breeze from the Northward B.H. steering S.W. by S at one hour P.M. raised the Island of Pape Carving S.W. at dark halled aback land 24 miles distant mid and latter parts the same at 5. Am kept ship off for Kraea and at 9. Am the Capt went on shore so ends this day

Saturday

Oct 16th. First of these 24 hours hazy weather and a strong breeze from N.E. B.H. staying off and on the Boat came on board at 1. P.M. mid & latter parts the same sent the Boat in again at 8. Am so ends this day

Sunday

Oct 17th. First of these 24 hours blowing & fresh gale from N.E. B.H. laying off & on it being so rugged the Boat did not come off to day mid & latter parts fine weather the Boat came off at 8. Am and returned on shore at 10 with two sick. Men Joseph Hermann & Jo. Seopes so ends this day

Monday

Oct 18th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & variable winds B.H. laying off & on the Capt came off at 5. P.M. and kept ship off S.W. Capt Joseph Hermann & Jo. Seopes on shore shipped a 4th. Mate a Mr. Honey also fetched off several green heads so ends this day Lat 14.05 Long 24.06

Tuesday

Oct 19th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & fresh breeze from N.E. B.H. steering S.W. saw 3 sail and a few Blackfish to day hands busily employed about decks mid & latter parts heavy squalls of wind & rain so ends this day Lat 12.08 the belt to our Kobetoy broke in the

Wednesday night fixed it by putting a chain & trap round the bowsprit

Oct 20th. First of these 24 hours light variable wind & calms with much rain mid & latter parts the same so ends Lat 12.04 Long 23.51

Thursday

Oct 21st. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light breeze from N.W. B.H. steering S.W. hands busily employed about decks mid & latter parts the same one sail in sight so ends this day Lat 11.15 Long 22.47

Friday

Oct 22nd. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light variable winds B.H. steering S.W. by S & by the wind mid & latter parts raining so ends this day Lat 9.57 Long 22.27

Saturday

Oct 23rd. First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & variable wind B.H. steering S.W. by the wind hands employed setting up main topmast rigging mid part raining latter parts fine weather so ends this day Lat 9.11 Long 21.44
