

Remarks On board R K

Thursday

Nov 18th. First of these 24 hours squally weather R K steering by the wind heading N N W mid & latter parts the same saw two sail to day so ends this day Lat 6.43 Long 28.00

Friday

Nov 19th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & moderate breeze from N E R K steering N N W one sail in sight hands busily employed about decks and in the rigging mid & latter parts the same so ends this day Lat 8.28 Long 28.30

Saturday

Nov 20th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & a fresh breeze from N E R K steering N N W saw several Pinbacks & Porpoises to day mid & latter parts strong breeze so ends this day Lat 10.19 Long 29.14

Sunday

Nov 21st. First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & a strong breeze from N E R K steering N N W saw one sail to day steering to the Northward mid & latter parts squally so ends this day Lat 12.13 Long 29.51

Monday

Nov 22nd. First of these 24 hours squally weather R K steering by the wind heading N N W by N mid & latter parts the same at 2 hours. And carried away our jibboom close to the Cap. got it in on deck & cleared the rigging also sent up new fore & Mainmast backstays so ends this day Lat 13.45 Long 30.18

Tuesday

Nov 23rd. First of these 24 hours fine weather & moderate breeze from N E R K steering N N W by the wind hands busily employed about decks & in the rigging saw one sail steering to the Northward mid & latter parts weather the same finished splicing our jib boom to day & sent it out & set up the rigging saw a sail steering to the Northward so ends this day Lat 15.11 Long 30.19

Wednesday

Nov 24th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light N E wind R K steering by the wind heading N N W hands busily employed about decks mid & latter parts strong breeze so ends this day Lat 16.25 Long 30.19

Thursday

Nov 25th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & a strong breeze from N E R K steering N N W by the wind repaired & bent the fly jib to day mid & latter parts much the same saw a Brig steering to the Northward made new presenter backropes & a new jib jumper so ends this day Lat 18.45 Long 29.40

Friday

Nov 26th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & moderate breeze from the Eastward R K steering N N W hands busily employed about decks mid & latter parts fine weather set up fore topmast rigging to day at 6 hours. And raised the Island of Trinidad so ends this day Lat 20.18 Long 29.21
