Saturday

Nov 27th. First of these 24 hours fine weather at 1 hour PM the Capt & 3rd. Wrote to these boats & went in fishing & returned at 4 PM and kept the ship off her course mid & latter parts the same saw a sail steering to the Southward so ends this day

Sunday

Nov 28th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & a moderate breeze from E. N. E. R R steering N E by E 1/2 E saw a sail steering to the Northward sent down our fore topsails for repairs & bent 2 spare ones mid part squally latter parts fine weather saw a sail steering to the Southward so ends this day

Monday

Nov 29th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & a moderate breeze from the Eastward saw a sail steering to the Northward mid & latter parts weather much the same hands employed repairing a panther so ends this day Lat 25.40 Long 26.34

Tuesday

Nov 30th. First of these 24 hours fresh breeze from N E R R steering N E by E saw 2 sail steering to the N finished repairing a panther & bent it mid & latter parts the same put out a new topsail yard to day & set the ship up & back so ends
Lat 27.37 Long 24.59

Wednesday

Dec 1st. First of these 24 hours fine weather & a fresh breeze from N E R R steering N E by E hands employed setting up head rigging mid & latter parts weather the same hands employed repairing lower fore topsail & main staysails so ends this day Lat 29.11 Long 23.29

Dec 2nd. First of these 24 hours fine weather & a Northward by wind R R steering N E by E finished repairing our sail & bent the Main staysail mid & latter parts weather much the same so ends this day
Lat 30.39 Long 21.35

Friday

Dec 3rd. First of these 24 hours fine weather & a moderate breeze from N W R R steering N E by E 1/2 E saw 3 compasses mid & latter parts light & variable winds so ends this day Lat 31.41 Long 20.19

Saturday

Dec 4th. First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & strong Southwesterly wind with passing showers R R steering by the wind heading N E by E mid & latter parts light wind saw a Frigate to day so ends Lat 32.11 Long 20.09

Sunday

Dec 5th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light S E wind R R steering by the wind on. Post tack mid & latter parts the same so ends this day
Lat 32.52 Long 20.15

Monday

Dec 6th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light S E wind R R steering by the wind heading N E by E mid part calm latter part light N E wind R R steering N E by E hands employed repairing fore topsail so ends this day Lat 33.35 Long 20.19

Tuesday

Dec 7th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & a fresh breeze from N E R R steering N E by E finished our topsail mid & latter parts weather the same saw a sail steering N E so ends this day
