

Remarks On board B K

Sunday

Jan 9th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light variable winds B K steering S E by E & by the wind saw plenty of Sulphur bottoms mid & latter parts weather much the same. Mr. Boney improving slowly so ends this day Lat 38.02 Long 58.48

Monday

Jan 10th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light Northwesterly winds B K steering E S E saw Sulphur bottoms to day mid & latter parts strong breeze so ends this day Lat 33.53 Long 62.56

Tuesday

Jan 11th. First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & a strong breeze from the Northward B K steering E S E mid & latter parts the same so ends Lat 38.47

Wednesday

Jan 12th. First of these 24 hours blowing fresh from the Northward at 3 P.M. wind shifted to S W and blew a gale B K steering E under lower topsails & fore sail mid & latter parts the same. Mr. Boney improving slowly so ends this day Lat 38.17 Long 62.55

Thursday

Jan 13th. First of these 24 hours blowing a gale from the Southward B K steering E S E mid & latter parts S E wind more moderate so ends this day Lat 37.40 Long 62.44

Friday

Jan 14th. First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & a strong breeze from S E B K steering by the wind mid & latter parts the same saw several Sulphur bottoms to day so ends Lat 36.58 Long 70.07

Saturday

Jan 15th. First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & a strong breeze from S E B K steering by the wind heading S E by E mid & latter parts weather the same so ends no obs

Sunday

Jan 16th. First of these 24 hours blowing fresh from S E B K steering by the wind heading S mid & latter parts the same so ends this day Lat 34.50 Long 70.59

Monday

Jan 17th. First of these 24 hours blowing a gale from the Eastward B K under lower topsails & staysails steering by the wind saw a school of Black fish to day mid & latter parts more moderate so ends this day Lat 33.40 Long 72.43

Tuesday

Jan 18th. First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & a fresh breeze from the Northward B K steering S E by E mid & latter parts weather the same so ends this day Lat 33.67 Long 75.55

Wednesday

Jan 19th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & a fresh breeze from the westward at 4 P.M. raised the Island of St. Pauls shortened sail & luffed to the wind at dark land bore E by N 5 miles distant mid & latter parts fine weather at 4. Am & 3 Boats went in fishing and got on board again at 12 O'clock so ends this day Lat 38.45

Thursday

Jan 20th. First of these 24 hours fine weather light winds & calm hands employed cleaning fish at dark Land bore west 12 miles distant mid & latter parts the same at 9 hours. Am raised a school of Blackfish lowered for them & the B K got 2 S E Bore so ends this day Lat 38.64 Long 78.34
