Friday
May 13th First of these 24 hours fine weather & calms
saw the Land mid & latter parts the same
gamed with ship games. Arnold to day
so ends this day no obs

Saturday
May 14th First of these 24 hours fine weather & light
wind & calm Sunday Island in sight all day
mid part fine latter part equally so ends no obs

Sunday
May 15th First of these 24 hours thick & squally weather
Blattering different courses fairs. Arnold
in sight also saw the Land mid part blowing
fresh from the Southward so ends this day
Lat 28.22 Long 178.57

Monday
May 16th First of these 24 hours blowing a gale from
the Southward. B K under lower main topsail
& staysails saw the Land some sail mid & latter
parts the same so ends this day
Lat 28.48 Long 178.36

Tuesday
May 17th First of these 24 hours blowing fresh from
S W with frequent squalls of rain saw the
Land mid & latter parts weather much the same
so ends this day Lat 27.52 Long 177.57

Wednesday
May 18th First of these 24 hours strong breeze from S W
B K steering N E by N mid & latter parts fine
weather so ends this day Lat 27.57 Long 176.58

Thursday
May 19th First of these 24 hours fine weather & westerly winds B K
steering by the wind on starboard tack at dark shortened sail
mid & latter parts fine weather so ends this day
Lat 28.06 Long 176.01

May 20th First of these 24 hours fine weather & light variable
wind B K steering by the wind on different tacks
saw a Pinbush to day mid & latter parts fine weather
at 7 hours Am raised a person who lies on our weather
Beam going to windward lowered the Boats but
never saw a spot from the Boats saw them three
cirings from the ship & then lost sight of them
so ends Lat 28.25 Long 177.11

Saturday
May 21st First of these 24 hours fine weather & E wind
Boats working to windward but never saw
anything at 4 Pm came on board mid & latter
parts weather much the same raised Sunday
Island at 8 Pm also saw several ship bottoms
so ends this day Lat 28.62 Long 177.48

Sunday
May 22nd First of these 24 hours fine weather & light
Easterly wind B K steering towards the Land
at dark shortened sail & luffed to the wind
Land bore S W 5 miles distant mid & latter parts
weather much the same stood close in to the
Land at 8 And the Capt went on shore so ends
Antone Pentecame on duty Lat 29.18

Monday
May 23rd First of these 24 hours cloudy weather
a strong breeze from the Eastward at 1 Pm
the Capt came on board & kept ship off
W by S at dark shortened sail mid & latter
parts blowing fresh from the Eastward
so ends this day Lat 29.15 Long 177.47
