Sunday

June 26th First of these 24 hours cloudy weather variable winds & frequent rain squalls mid & latter parts weather much the same so ends this day no obs put John Mc Donald in Irons to day for a few hours Mr. Furlong off duty with his leg cut

Monday

June 27th First of these 24 hours variable winds with much rain B K steering N by W mid & latter parts better weather so ends this day Lat 23.52 Long 174.56

Tuesday

June 28th First of these 24 hours fine weather & southerly wind B K steering N W W saw one Finback mid & latter parts hazy weather & strong breeze so ends this day Lat 21.35 Long 174.14

Wednesday

June 29th First of these 24 hours thick hazy weather & strong breeze from N E B K steering N W W at dark shortened sail & luffed to the wind mid & latter parts the same at daylight raised the Island of Eson kept ship off for it so ends this day no obs

Thursday

June 30th First of these 24 hours blowing fresh from S E B K steering in for Tonga at noon came to anchor at 2 hours P.M. in 15 fathoms water mid & latter parts squally shiped in our gibboun to day so ends this day

Friday

July 1st First of these 24 hours strong Easterly winds hands employed gib & fly gib gyes mid & latter parts weather the same so ends this day

Saturday

July 2nd First of these 24 hours fine weather & moderate breeze from the Eastward hands busily employed about decks one Boats crew cutting wood mid & latter parts weather much the same so ends this day

Sunday

July 3rd First of these 24 hours fine weather & Easterly wind hands employed setting up head rigging & cutting wood mid & latter parts strong Easterly wind so ends this day

Monday

July 4th First of these 24 hours blowing fresh from the Eastward mid part the same latter part more moderate hands employed in various jobs about decks & some cutting wood

Tuesday

July 5th First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & Easterly wind hands busily employed about decks mid & latter parts strong winds from E N E with frequent showers so ends this day

Wednesday

July 6th First of these 24 hours blowing fresh from E N E hands employed cutting wood & doing other jobs about decks & in the rigging mid & latter parts weather much the same so ends this day

Thursday

July 7th First of these 24 hours strong Easterly wind hands employed repairing fly gib mid & latter parts weather much the same Secar's Holen back off duty sick so ends this day

Friday

July 8th First of these 24 hours blowing hard from the N E hands employed repairing the gib mid & latter parts weather the same so ends this day

Saturday

July 9th First of these 24 hours blowing a fresh gale from the Northward hands employed about decks mid & latter parts much rain Secar's Holen back off duty sick so ends this day
