

Remarks On board B.H.

Saturday

July 10th. First of these 24 hours cloudy weather variable wind hands employed getting wood from shore mid & latter parts weather the same at 8 hours. Am weighed. Anchor & dropped our ship further down board the reef so ends

Sunday

July 11th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light wind from S.W. at 8 hours. Am hove up our anchor & dropped ship further off shore so ends

Tuesday

July 12th. First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & Easterly wind hands employed in various jobs about decks sent our cutting blocks off to day mid & latter parts fine weather lowered 2 Boats this morning to Crisis for Humpback so ends this day

Wednesday

July 13th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & variable wind. Boats Cruising for whales saw one but did not get near enough to strike at 4 P.M. came on board mid & latter parts squally so ends

Thursday

July 14th. First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & frequent squalls hands employed in various jobs about decks mid & latter parts squally. Mr. Furlong the 3rd. Mate left the ship today the Capt told him that he might go or stop but he was not to head a Boat any longer so he took his things & went on shore so ends this day

Friday

July 15th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & a strong breeze from the Eastward mid & latter parts fine weather so ends this day

Saturday

July 16th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & N.E. wind hands employed firing the bands to the topsail yards mid & latter parts weather the same so ends this day

Sunday

July 17th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & Northward by wind part of the crew went on liberty to day mid & latter parts raining all the men came off to day so ends

Monday

July 18th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & variable wind with passing showers mid & latter parts fine weather so ends this day

Tuesday

July 19th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & E. wind the Capt came on board to day & brought a man with him by the name of. Meril who I believe has shipped as 3rd. Mate mid & latter parts fine weather lowered 4 Boats to day for Humpback so ends this day

Wednesday

July 20th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & Easterly winds saw several Humpback & the 1st. Boat started at one but he was too deep at dark came on board mid & latter parts blowing fresh so ends this day

Thursday

July 21st. First of these 24 hours blowing fresh from all parts of the compass with much rain mid & latter much the same lowered 3 Boats to day to look for Humpback Lewis Kolenback off duty sick so ends

Friday

July 22nd. First of these 24 hours strong & variable wind with much rain never saw any whales to day mid & latter parts raining so ends this day
