same so ends this day

Aug 7th Sunday First of these 24 hours blowing fresh from
W. Boats cruising for Humpback came
on board at 3 Pm mid & latter parts rainy so ends

Aug 8th Monday First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & variable wind
mid & latter parts fine weather moved the ship
further out to day lowered the Boats to cruise so ends

Aug 9th Tuesday First of these 24 hours strong Easterly wind
at 2 hours Pm the Le Betruck & whale boat
her to spouting blood soon after she rounded
& took the line chased for several hours & at night
came on board mid & latter parts the same
lowered the Boats this morning to cruise so ends

Aug 10th Wednesday First of these 24 hours fine weather & Easterly
First wind Boats came on board at half past 4 Pm
mid & latter parts the same lowered the Boats
this morning to cruise so ends this day
Carpenter came on duty to day

Aug 12th Friday First of these 24 hours blowing fresh from E. & E.
Boats came on board at 4 Pm mid & latter parts the
same lowered the Boats this morning but came on
board at 11 Am so ends this day

Aug 13th Saturday First of these 24 hours weather improving
lowered 2 Boats this afternoon the W B struck
a whale killed him & took him to the ship
mid & latter parts strong breeze lowered the Boats
this morning the W B struck a whale & got
stove while lancing of him but killed the whale
came on board & got another Boat from off the
house the James Arnolds struck a whale & got
3 Boats stove now our Le B & P. B. killed them
kill their whale so ends this day

Aug 14th Sunday First of these 24 hours strong Easterly wind
got our whale long side at 4 Pm then sent
the Boats to help the James Arnolds folks
got him long side at 8 Pm mid & latter parts
fine weather hooked on to our whale at 7 Am
& finished at noon so ends this day

Aug 15th Monday First of these 24 hours fine weather & Easterly
wind hooked on to our other whale at 1 Pm finished
at 3 started to sail at 8 Pm took Le weid Holenbach
ashore to day mid & latter parts weather the same
lowered 3 Boats to day so ends this day
