Aug 16th

Thursday First of these 24 hours fine weather & light breeze from E. N. E. Boats came on board at 6. P.M. mid & latter parts weather the same lowered the Boats this morning to cruise so ends.

Aug 17th

Wednesday First of these 24 hours fine weather & W. wind the B. struck a whale at 2. P.M. killed her & got her to the ship at 8. P.M. mid & latter parts variable wind & raining looked on to our whale at 8. A.M. so ends this day.

Thursday

Aug 18th First of these 24 hours fine weather & southerly wind finished cutting our whale at 2. P.M. mid part the same latter part blowing fresh from the Westward employed boiling lowered 3 Boats to day so ends this day.

Aug 19th

Friday First of these 24 hours blowing fresh from the Westward the W. B. went on to a whale but did not get fast the chance was good. mid & latter parts the same finished boiling at 2 hours. And lowered the Boats this morning to cruise so ends this day.

Aug 20th

Saturday First of these 24 hours blowing hard from S. W. Boats came on board early to get ready to slow down mid & latter parts fine weather hands employed stowing down so ends this day.

Aug 21st

Sunday First of these 24 hours fine weather & S. W. wind finished stowing down at 3 hours. P.M. mid & latter parts fine weather.

Aug 23rd

Tuesday First of these 24 hours fine weather & S. E. wind at 3. P.M. the B. struck a whale killed her & took her to the ship mid & latter parts the same lowered 2 Boats this morning the W. B. struck a whale the wind off shore so had to cut so ends.

Aug 24th

Wednesday First of these 24 hours fine weather & light Easterly wind finished cutting our whale at 4. P.M. mid & latter parts strong breeze employed boiling lowered 3 Boats this morning so ends.

Aug 25th

Thursday First of these 24 hours blowing fresh from the Eastward. Boats came on board at 3. P.M. mid & latter parts the same finished boiling at 4. A.M. lowered the Boats this morning so ends.

Aug 26th

Friday First of these 24 hours blowing fresh from N. E. Boats came on board at 5. P.M. mid & latter parts weather much the same lowered the Boats this morning & the B. struck a whale killed it so ends.

Aug 27th

Saturday First of these 24 hours fine weather & light N. E. wind got our whale to the ship at half past 4. P.M. mid & latter parts the same lowered 2 Boats to day also cut in our whale so ends this day.

Aug 28th

Sunday First of these 24 hours fine weather & calm mid & latter parts raining employed boiling so ends this day. To wood. K. S. Lambach who went on shore on the 16th of the month did not want to come off so he still remains on shore.
